- 1. Hampstead Tea London White Tea Makaibari Estate, \$24.95 (50g).** Organic, Fairtrade-certified and biodynamic, this tea is steeped with more than antioxidants. It's sourced from a plantation bordered by rainforests in the Himalayas and only a few hundred kilograms are produced a year. Stockists: David Jones, Macro Wholefoods Market.
- 2. Be Genki Tranquility Herbal Tea, \$20 (40g).** 'Genki' means happy and healthy in Japanese, and when you're drinking this infusion of fragrant goodies, why wouldn't you be? The company donates five per cent of its sales to environmental sustainability campaigns. You have to be genki with that. Stockists: www.begenki.com.au.
- 3. Clipper Organic Green Tea, \$3.99 (50g).** This tea from the *Camellia sinensis* plant is said to have anti-carcinogenic qualities. You'll feel even better knowing the leaves are organic and harvested in accordance with Fairtrade standards. Stockists: Marco Wholefoods Market.
